

Processing of Alumni data

Who is the controller of the data processing?

What is the purpose of the personal data processing?

IQS collects the personal data of individuals who register as Alumni for the purpose of providing services, for career advice and guidance, offering training services, organizing activities, and for information.

How long does IQS store the data?

Personal data is erased when requested by the data subject.

What are the legal grounds for data processing?

Data processing is done based on the consent given by the data subject. A data subject can withdraw their consent at any time.

To whom are the data communicated?

As a general rule, data are not communicated to other parties unless the data subject gives consent.

What rights exist in relation to data processing?

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether IQS is processing their personal data. If so, you have the right to know the purpose for which the data are intended and the communications that have been made or are expected to be made. The law recognizes the right of data subjects to access their data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, to request their erasure when the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected and there is no obligation to store them. Erasure must be done immediately when IQS processes the data solely on the basis of the consent of the data subject. In certain circumstances, data subjects may request the limitation of the processing of their data, a right that gives them control over such data mainly in order to rectify inappropriate processing and to lodge complaints in defence of their rights.

How can rights be exercised or defended?

By means of a letter addressed to the references indicated in the first paragraph. If a data subject believes that their rights have not been adequately addressed, they can lodge a complaint with the Catalan Data Protection Authority (www.apd.cat).
